

## **DEFENDING DURING LIMITED VISIBILITY**

<b>ITEM</b>	<b>ACTION</b>	<b>✓</b>
<b>1</b>	<b>Employ long range STANO equip (GSR, sensors, NOD)</b>	
<b>2</b>	<b>Coordinate any movement outside battle psn boundaries with higher and adjacent units</b>	
<b>3</b>	<b>Redeploy some units &amp; weapons to concentrate along dismounted avenues of approach</b>	
<b>4</b>	<b>Employ scouts, OP, patrols, ambushes, and armor killer teams forward on secondary AA and between positions</b>	
<b>5</b>	<b>Employ nuisance obstacles and early warning devices along likely night approaches</b>	

<b>DEFENDING DURING LIMITED VISIBILITY</b>		
<b>ITEM</b>	<b>ACTION</b>	<b>✓</b>
<b>6</b>	<b>Plan required movement of weapons, units, and massing of fires on enemy approaches</b>	
<b>7</b>	<b>Rehearse movement of weapons, units, and massing of fires on enemy approaches</b>	
<b>8</b>	<b>Reposition weapons to take advantage of differences between enemy and friendly STANO devices</b>	
<b>9</b>	<b>Plan illumination on or behind engagement areas to silhouette enemy</b>	

<b>DEFENDING DURING LIMITED VISIBILITY</b>		
<b>ITEM</b>	<b>ACTION</b>	<b>✓</b>
10	Move <b>TRPs</b> and/or <b>EAs</b> closer to defensive positions or move weapons closer to them- use <b>METT-T</b>	
11	Commence adjustments to defensive organization before dark	
12	Complete return to daylight positions before dawn	
13	Move closer to avenue(s) of approach you guard during bad weather	
14	Be aware that sensors and radar may still penetrate bad weather
